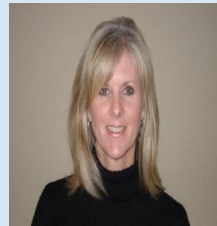

Airport Options - Pendleton, WA; Tri-Cities (Pasco, WA); and Walla Walla, WA.

1. Pendleton requires a flight into Portland and then the shuttle flight SeaPort to Pendleton. (8 miles to Resort)
2. Pasco has direct flights from numerous hubs in the area. (90 miles to Resort)
3. Walla Walla has direct flights from Seattle only with flights at least twice daily. (45 miles to Resort)

Driving Directions

- From I-84 (Portland, Oregon (211 miles) / Seattle, Washington (290 miles)): Follow I-84 to Exit 216 (4 miles East of Pendleton, Oregon). Turn left at the exit and proceed North on Hwy. 331. Wildhorse Resort & Casino on right.
- From Tri-Cities, Washington: Follow I-82 South enter Oregon and take I-84 East and then Exit 216 (4 miles East of Pendleton, Oregon). Turn left at the exit and proceed North on Hwy. 331. Wildhorse Resort on your right.
- From Walla Walla, Washington: Follow Hwy 11 South to Oregon and take the Mission Exit. Head South on Hwy 331 for approximately 10 miles. Wildhorse Resort & Casino will be on your left.
